2	<b>Reservations</b>	Reservation of Seats: 27% seats for OBC, 15% seats for SC, 7.5% seats for ST and 5% seats for person with disability (PWD) as per the reservation policy of the Government of India (with minimum disability to the extent of 40%) in pursuance of Provisions of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016.  Reservation for EWS: The persons belonging to EWSs who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs shall get 10% reservation in Admission to various programmes of study except M.Phil and Ph.D.
3	Ph.D. and M.Phil Computer Based Test (CBT)	The examination would be held on all India basis. Final selection for M.Phil & Ph.D. would be with 70% weightage for entrance examination and 30% weightage for Viva-Voce. For details kindly refer to Admission Policy 2019-20 available on JNU website.

In the event of their selection they will be entitled to admission only if they have secured the minimum prescribed percentage of marks in their qualifying examination and they submit all documents including final marks-sheets of qualifying examination before the deadline fixed for registration.

22	<b>Deprivation Points</b>	
	a) Who are eligible for Deprivation Points for Quartile Districts?	The benefit of deprivation points will be extended only to candidates seeking admission in UG/PG/M.Tech/MPH/PGDE/Part-time programmes.
	b) Basis on which deprivation points are awarded	Benefit of deprivation points is given on the basis of particulars furnished by the candidates in the relevant field of the online application form. In case of failure to produce documentary evidence at the time of admission/registration, the candidate will be declared as ineligible for the benefit of deprivation points and his/her merit rank/eligibility for admission would be reviewed accordingly. In case of submission of false information by the candidate, his/her admission will be cancelled, ipso-facto.
23	<b>Percentile and Normalization procedure:</b>	(i) For multi-shift papers, raw marks obtained by the candidates in different shifts/sessions will be converted to NTA Score (percentile). (ii) The detailed procedure on NTA Score being adopted is available on Annexure-XIII under Normalization procedure based on Percentile Score. (iii) In case a subject test is conducted in multi-shifts, NTA Score will be calculated corresponding to the raw marks obtained by a candidate. The calculated NTA Score for the

		<p>Raw Marks for all the shifts/sessions will be merged for further processing for deciding the allocation.</p> <p>(iv) In the events of the percentiles for the multi-shifts being dissimilar / unequal, the lowest will be the eligibility cut-off for that category for all candidates (i.e. all shifts). For Example: In an the examination held in two shifts, if the 40% marks correspond to a Percentile score of 78 in Shift 1 and 79 in Shift 2, then all those equal to or above 78 percentiles (Percentile score of 100 to 78) in both shifts will become eligible in General Category. Similar method will be adopted for the other categories to determine eligibility cut-offs. In case the examination is held in more number of shifts the same principle shall apply.</p>
